

APPLICATION

The Jabsco Rotary Vane pump is ideal for transferring diesel fuel. The brass rotor and bronze vanes are not affected by petroleum products. It is self-priming with a suction lift of up to eight feet and can pump against a discharge head of up to ten feet.

NOTICE: Do not pump water or corrosive fluids. Do not pump oils with a viscosity greater than SAE 10W. Pump and/or motor damage may result.

INSTALLATION

The pump must be mounted in a dry location positioned horizontally the motor is not waterproof and must not be submerged. SELECTION OF A COOL, VENTILATED location will generally extend pump motor life. The pump may be mounted at 90 degree increments on the bearing house to allow plumbing connections as needed.

PLUMBING CONNECTIONS

Pumps ports are tapped with 1" NPT threads. Use rigid plumbing or flexible hose that does not kink when bent and with sufficient wall thickness to prevent collapse when used on suction side of pump. Plumbing should be routed so that some fluid will be retained in pump body to wet the rotor and vanes. Wetting the rotor and vanes aids in priming. Use a strainer on the intake if debris or solids are present in the fluid being pumped. ALL plumbing connections must be airtight to enable fast priming.



ELECTRICAL CONNECTIONS

Connect black wire to negative (–) terminal of battery. The orange wire with the fuse holder should run to an overload protected switch or circuit breaker, with a wire from switch or breaker to positive (+) terminal of battery. Motor rotation is clockwise looking at shaft end of motor. Use proper sire size as determined by wire table elsewhere on this sheet. Should this fuse blow, replace with same size fuse after determining reason for blown fuse.

Above recommendations are for a maximum 3% voltage drop.

NOTICE: To prevent motor damage, use only multi-strand copper wire in size recommended. DO NOT use ordinary lamp cord or other substitutes.


NOTICE: No warranty consideration will be given to pumps that are returned without the properly sized fuse and fuse holder supplied with the pump.

OPERATION


Rotary Vane pumps must NOT be run dry, as the pumped liquid is the lubricant for the rotor and vanes. Observe the outlet and shut off pump as soon as liquid stops flowing.

The pump cannot run against a closed outlet such as encountered when using a garden hose type shut-off nozzle. Pressure for normal operation should not exceed 10 feet of head (4.3 PSI). Excessive pressures will cause fuse to blow.

Temperature of pumped liquid may be in the range of 45°-165°F (10°-78°C).

DISASSEMBLY

- 1. Disconnect pump from electrical supply.
- 2. Disconnect plumbing from pump.
- 3. Remove the 4 hexagon screws holding body to seal housing.
- Partially withdraw body then push vanes into rotor, hold in position and remove body.
- Mark the ends of the vanes and end of rotor to ensure that the vanes will be returned to their respective slots in rotor.
- Loosen set screw on coupling (using an allen wrench). Locate screw through access hole in seal housing. Withdraw rotor and shaft assembly.
- Remove hexagon head screws which secure seal housing to motor. Withdraw motor.
- Inspect seal and shaft bushings for wear and only remove if necessary.
- Vanes must be replaced when width has reduced to 7/16" (dimension when new - 1/2").

Motor Removal Only

- 1. Disconnect electrical supply.
- Use allen wrench through access hole in seal housing to loosen set screw in coupling.
- Remove 2 hexagon head bolts (key 12) which secure seal housing to motor and withdraw motor.

MAINTENANCE

Check wires and connections to be sure corrosion is not adding additional resistance to the motor circuit and causing a low voltage condition at the motor. Full voltage should be available to prevent motor damage.

If pump is to be in freezing temperatures, drain by loosening end cover screws.

ASSEMBLY

- Install new shaft bushings if required.
 Note: If grooved shaft bushing is to be replaced, ensure that
 the groove is positioned opposite the groove in the inside face
 of the pump body. Both bushings must be flush or below the
 face of the pump body and seal housing.
- Install new seal, if required. Ensure seal lip points toward bushing.
- 3. Grease bushing and lip of lip seal.
- Carefully push rotor shaft through seal housing bushing and seal.
- Install vanes into their respective slots. If new vanes are installed, radiused edges must be facing outwards.
- Clean faces of body, seal housing and O-ring groove. Install O-ring.
- Assemble body onto shaft and seal housing. Secure with hexagon screws and washers.
- 8. Check location of set screw in coupling.
- Align flat in shaft with coupling set screw and slide seal housing/pump assembly over coupling/motor assembly. Insert rotor shaft into coupling and locate seal housing against motor face. Secure with screws and lock washers. Ensure spring coupling is not under pressure and tighten set screw.

Receipt verifying purchase date is required to obtain adjustment.
- Buyer shall notify ITT of any defect within this warranty no later than ninety (90) days after the defect is discovered.
- No product will be accepted for return or replacement without the prior written authorization of ITT. Upon such authorization, and in accordance with instructions from ITT, the product will be returned to ITT, shipping charges prepaid by Buyer. Products returned to ITT will be addressed as follows:

Repair or replacement made under this warranty will be shipped prepaid to Buyer.
