INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

The PAR electric toilet may be installed above or below the waterline. Flush pump is self priming up to 6 feet, discharge macerator pump can operate up to 4 foot head.

Inlet and outlet seacocks should be easily accessible and be positive shut off valves. If seacocks cannot be conveniently operated from toilet location, install suitable shut off valves for inlet and discharge connections.

Base assembly may be moved 90° to accommodate connections and provide accessibility for servicing.

PLUMBING CONNECTIONS — Connect inlet hose using either 5/8" or 3/4" ID hose (a sleeve is included to adapt pump inlet from 5/8" to 3/4"). Make sure all inlet connections are air tight and free of sharp bends or restrictions.

Connect 1" or 1-1/2" hose to discharge port (Adapter 98023-0080 is included to convert discharge port to 1-1/2" I.D. hose), and make suitable connection to holding tank or other discharge system. Avoid sharp bends or restrictions.

For installations below waterline use vented loop in discharge hose about 8 inches above waterline at all angles of heel or trim.

For above waterline installations a check valve may have to be installed in the flush water intake line.

For installations above waterline make a loop in the discharge line about 8 inches above base of bowl to retain water in bowl.

WIRING HOOKUP: Wire with heavy duty stranded copper wire throughout. For 12 volt, use #12 gauge for less than 10' run; #10 gauge for up to 20' run. For 24 and 32 volt, use #14 gauge for less than 10' run; #12 gauge for up to 20' run. Complete the installation with PAR switch and fuse panel: No. 37020-0000 (12 volt), 37020-0001 (24 volt), or 37020-0002 (32 volt). If other switch is used, adequate amperage capacity is necessary: Use a 25 amp. fuse for 12 volt; 15 amp. fuse for 24 volt, or 10 amp. fuse for 32 volt.

IMPORTANT

Connect orange wire to positive circuit, and black wire to negative for proper rotation. Failure to connect wires as described will damage unit and void warranty.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS


Make sure inlet and outlet seacocks are all open, push button to operate. Operate until bowl is completely flushed and discharge pump has scavenged water from bottom of howl

The PAR electric marine toilet will provide years of trouble-free service if properly used. It will handle waste and toilet tissue. It will NOT handle rags, sanitary napkins or hard solid objects.

If bowl does not pump out and begins to fill, partially close inlet valve until bowl is cleared and completely pumped out. Then operate for a few seconds with both valves open to clear entire toilet and discharge system. After each operation close both the inlet and outlet seacocks.

To drain for winter layup, close inlet valve and operate for a few seconds until all water is pumped out.

DISASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Disconnect Pump inlet, outlet and discharge hoses. Remove four screws, Key #23, pull out complete motor, pump and macerator assembly. If assembly does not slide out easily, push forward and pull back sharply several times to free macerator housing from base.


Remove discharge port, Key #13, and check valve. Unscrew chopper plate, Key #15, by turning counterclockwise, facing plate. Prevent shaft from turning by placing screwdriver in discharge port and locking centrifugal impeller blade. Remove macerator housing. Loosen impeller set screw and slide shaft sleeve and impeller off motor shaft.

Remove four flathead screws, Key #20 & 21, wearplate, Key #22, gasket, Key #24. Slide pump assembly off motor shaft. Replace all worn or damaged parts, clean remaining parts.

Press seal into body with lip facing impeller, be careful not to cock seal in bore. Install pump body on motor and position on register, lubricate impeller bore with pump grease. Put O'ring into wearplate groove. Install impeller, gasket and wearplate. Make sure gasket surfaces are clean and smooth. Tighten wearplate screws. Slide shaft sleeve onto shaft until it seats against rubber impeller (#25). Relocate centrifugal impeller against sleeve on shaft and tighten set screw. Place macerator housing over shaft and impeller, put lock washer on end of shaft and screw chopper plate on shaft and tighten. Install gasket on wearplate surface, a little grease will help hold in place, make sure inside body surfaces are clean, line up slot in body with key on macerator housing, slide assembly into body and tighten with the four screws. Turn motor on for one of two seconds to be sure centrifugal impeller is free.
