



Washdown pumps come in two main varieties. High pressure, low flow models are typically self-priming and come with an automatic demand switch that controls their operation much like a water system pump. Low pressure, high flow models are operated by a manual switch and normally require flooded suction. Most washdown pumps can be utilized for baitwell operation. However, there are many models specifically designed for baitwell service.

1-1/2" to 3" Hydraulic Drive Up to 280 gpm



Pacer "S" Series

These high volume pumps are self-priming to 20 feet and can move massive amounts of water for commercial deck wash or livewell applications. Gasoline, electric, or pulley driven versions are available. (See page 27)

Washdown Kit With Nozzle Up to 4.3 gpm, 50 psi



31700 Series by Jabsco

These saltwater or freshwater washdown pumps will also supply a baitwell with up to 250 gallons per hour. They come with a continuous duty motor that has a waterproof coating and sealed pressure switch. (See page 19)

Bronze Clutch Driven Electric or Manual

These commercial duty flexible impeller pumps come in manual or electric (12, 24 or 32 vdc) operation and are suitable for washdown, bilge and as a back-up fire-fighting pump. They come in 1" through 2" port sizes and will deliver up to 83 gpm. (See page 27)

Rule TBs series utilizes a unique transom mount that eliminates the need to install another thru-hull fitting to supply your baitwell. Sizes range from 360 to 1100 gallons per hour. (See page 20)

This electrically driven self-priming pump comes in bronze or cast iron construction and will lift up to 20 feet, comes in 1 1/2" or 2" ports and will deliver flows up to 150 gpm and pressures up to 80 psi. (See page 60)

The continuous duty Aqua Tiger provides up to 20 gpm at low pressure. It comes standard with 3/4" FPT ports, stainless steel housing and clog resistant open impeller. (See page 21)

This antique design has stood the test of time. Hook it up on your freshwater dock, shallow well, or cistern to fill your bucket or wash your fish. It has a 1 1/4" suction port, stands 16 inches high and will lift up to 6 feet.!
