GENERAL SAFETY AND OPERATION

1. Use with the proper electrical receptacle. On single phase models cord is supplied with a grounding type, 3-prong plug.
NOTE: DO NOT USE GROUNDING ADAPTER.
2. Do not use if outer covering of cord becomes excessively cut or worn.
3. Each pump comes with a built-in handle for lifting. For added convenience, the 899045 25 ft. marine rope can be attached to the handle.

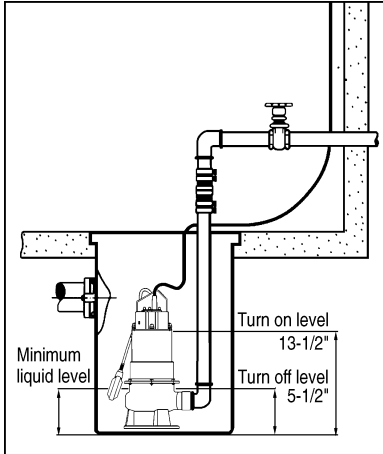
WARNING

Do not lift with power cord. This can cause damage to the connection and result in shock or serious injury.

4. Continued cycling on and off is an indication the motor is in overload. Make certain the pump is level and adequately submerged in liquid.

NOTE: CONTINUED OPERATION WITH EXCESSIVE CYCLING WILL OVERHEAT AND BURN OUT MOTOR.

5. All automatic models come with a Float Switch to shut-off unit when liquid level drops below safe operation. For field retro-fit, the 899080 [115V] or 899081 [230V] Float Switch can be added to automate the manual units.



TROUBLESHOOTING

PUMP WON'T START

- Blown fuse or tripped circuit
- Low voltage line
- Defective motor
- Impeller clogged
- Not primed
- Check power supply.
- Check power supply.
- Overheated and burned out unit must be replaced.
- Check for proper particle size. Maximum 2" and 2% concentrate and raise from bottom of pit.
- Reposition pump in liquid with minimum 5-1/2" liquid.

PUMP CYCLES ON AND OFF

- Insufficient liquid
- Pump run dry
- Liquid temperature to high
- Reposition pump in pit or remove if liquid is too low.
- Keep liquid within pump limits. Remove if liquid is low.
- Keep liquid within pump limits.

PUMP OPERATES BUT DELIVERS LITTLE FLOW

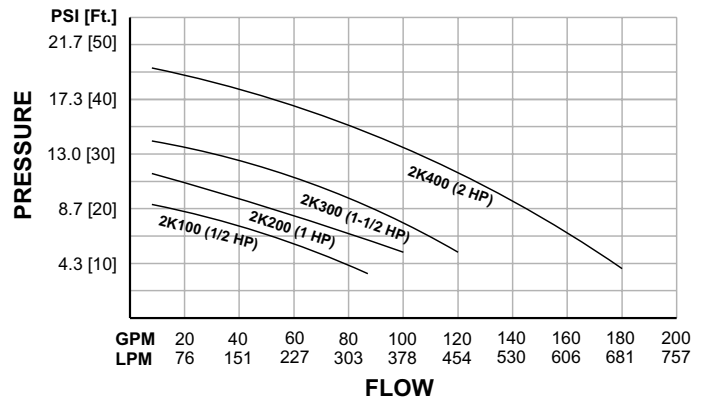
- Impeller clogged
- Low voltage
- Worn seals
- Check liquid and particle size. Flush impeller area.
- Check power supply.
- Replace pump unit.

WARRANTY

This pump is warranted for one year from date of purchase.

Improper installation and use will void the warranty. Tampering with the power cord, impeller or seals will void the warranty.

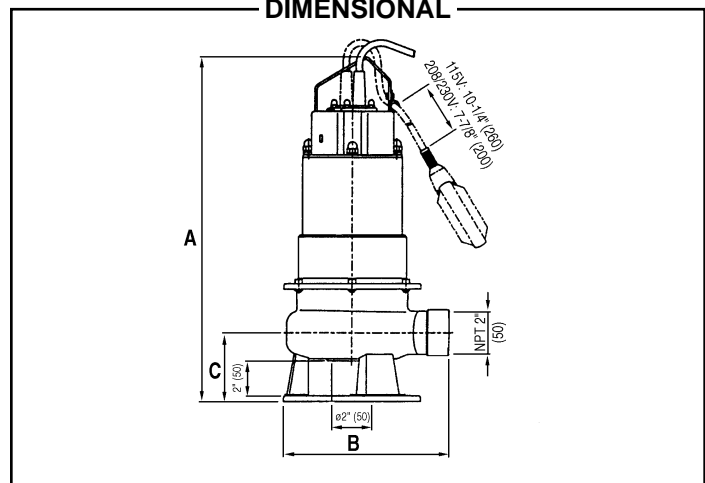
